Palm Sunday, Holy Week & Easter

Sunday, March 25 - Palm Sunday - 10:00 AM

This service marks the beginning of Holy Week. Be present to discover your own rootedness in the drama which is Christ's passion, a drama that has no audience. As we begin this holiest of weeks, this is a drama in which we are participants. Come and allow the Passion story to embrace you, name you, shape your very being and become your story!

Maundy Thursday, March 29 - 7:00 PM Eucharist

Jesus is making his journey to the cross. That journey includes time with the disciples in that upper room meal where Jesus gives us a new commandment and greets us



with his very life and blood. Be present in the quiet as the altar is stripped and we follow Jesus' journey to Gethsemane.

Good Friday, March 30 – 7:00 PM Service – at St. Paul's Lutheran Church

On the evening of this day we call "Good," be present as we join the congregation of St. Paul's Lutheran Church to experience the Service of Tenebrae. From Latin, the word **Tenebrae** means "darkness" and commemorates the final hours of our Lord's life on earth as he suffered death upon the cross. As the candles are extinguished, they symbolize the fading loyalty of the disciples and friends of Jesus. The gradual darkening of the church portrays the diminishing light of the world as Christ was departing from it. Easter Sunday, April 1 – Easter Breakfast & 10:00 Eucharist Come and join us for a delicious breakfast on this most festive of
