In just a few short weeks, we will again experience the beginning of the new - a new church year. And, with that turn of the year, Advent will be upon us.

I love living the spirit of Advent, a spirit of anticipatory waiting. In a culture where waiting is something we want to discard, eliminate from our experience and replace with fast, immediate service of every kind, waiting is a practice to be practiced.

A sense of great joy can be found when one waits, especially when one waits with great anticipation and eagerness for someone who deeply loves us, for someone whom we deeply love. One of my seminary professors once likened this aspect of Advent to "sitting at the airport waiting for your loved one to arrive." I understand that metaphor, having spent four years away at seminary. Every time I waited for my husband to come for a visit, or waited to travel to meet him, I knew what it meant to wait with such anticipation. I knew in a very experiential and tangible way what it means to be "at the airport waiting for your loved one to arrive."
