# **Out of Order Documentary Community Screening**

Faith Lutheran is joining together with 5 other community churches to host a community screening of *Out of Order: Queer Pastors Redefining Church. Out of Order* is a groundbreaking feature documentary revealing the complex and painful struggles faced by lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGBTQ) faith leaders.

The free screening will be held on Tuesday, September 25, at Studio C! in Okemos. Doors will open at 6:30 p.m. with the event starting at 7:00 p.m. and lasting about 2 hours.

## **GREEN TEAM NEWS** –



The Green Team is planning a **Consumers Energy Workshop/Luncheon event for Sunday, September 30, following worship**.

Consumers Energy representatives will be here to share information regarding the Helping Neighbors Program they are offering to customers. This program encourages customers to have a Free Energy Audit done on their home. Faith Lutheran Church will get credit for all energy audits done using the Faith Lutheran code that has been provided for us (FAITHLU18).

If 50 homes, *anywhere in the state of Michigan*, have this done, Faith Lutheran Church will receive \$500 from Consumers. If we are able to get more homeowners to register and receive this free audit, we could receive up to \$2,000 from Consumers.

September 30 will be the kick-off event for this fundraising effort. The Green Team hopes to raise enough money to eventually put more insulation in the attic of the Parish House and replace the front window of the house with something that is more energy efficient. Consumers Energy desires that we have 50 people attend this kickoff/informational luncheon. *A sign-up sheet will be available in the narthex,* so Consumers knows approximately how much food they will need to provide.
