In a series of six class sessions, Walter


Brueggemann, arguably America's leading Old Testament scholar and theologian, will take you on a wild ride through the poetic prophecy of the Hebrew Scriptures. He will identify cultural contexts, putting a framework to Israel's history, and most significantly – and at times challengingly! – draw connections between Israel's sociological, economic and spiritual status and that of America today.

Created in 2011, this series will lead you through questions like:

- What was the message of these remarkable poet-prophets in their own time and place?
- What is their message for us today?
- Who are today's prophetic voices?
- How has the contemporary church been co-opted by culture?
- What steps can we take to reclaim the prophetic message of distributive justice, nonviolence, loss and hope?
- And, what is your role in bringing God's perspective to today's society?

Each session begins with a 10-15 minute video presentation by Walter Brueggemann, followed by filmed interaction with a diverse small group. Then, Kim O'Brien will lead you through a discussion of what you have learned.


