From the Pastor's Pen...

Dear Friends.

As we continue to navigate the world of COVID-19, I continue to think about what it means to live into a life-giving, daring confidence in the grace of God in this present world. I have been thinking about how we, the community of God's people who gather at Faith Lutheran Church, live that daring confidence in God's grace.

Gathering, even if we are wearing masks, is a vital and necessary aspect of being a community of Faith.

Living into a life-giving confidence in God's grace is seen as we are intentional about our weekly gathering together at the foot of the cross for worship. I believe it is at the foot of the cross that our life as a community is continually born anew and nurtured for life in the world, even a COVID plagued world. It is at the foot of the cross that we most fully discover our identity as the body of Christ, and it is from this place that we journey together as a community of Faith, living our faith through our varied vocations in daily life.


