FIRST READING: Jeremiah 28:5-9

Through a symbolic action Jeremiah insisted that Judah and all the surrounding nations should submit to the king of Babylon (Jer. 27). God confirmed the word of Jeremiah and sentenced the false prophet Hananiah to death (vv. 16-17).

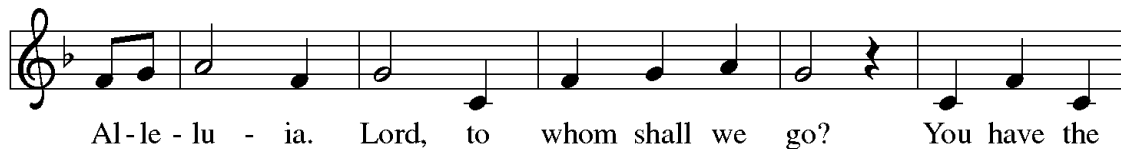




