PASTOR'S CORNER

Yahweh's favor is not exhausted, nor has God's compassion failed. They rise up new every morning, so great is God's faithfulness. Lamentations 3:22-23 The Inclusive Bible

It is hard to imagine that Yahweh's favor is not exhausted, as ours gets exhausted. We only have so much favor and then we are done with that person or activity. We do have different levels of compassion, but God's compassion hasn't failed.

It is important to step back at times from people and activities in our lives as we do become exhausted. We only have a human beings' compacity for dealing with people and things. We will get exhausted if we do not take care of ourselves and let God take care of things.

This does not mean that we don't do anything, but as human beings, we have limits. Thankfully God does not. When our favor and compassion are failing, then it is time to step back. God may be trying to tell us that God needs to take care of this.

What I have observed is that Faith is anxious to move forward. Once the transition team makes their presentation to the council at their June meeting, I will work with the council to finish up the work for the Ministry Site Profile. Once this is completed the Council will convene the Call Committee.

Once the MSP is submitted to the ELCA/Synod, the bishop will see what candidates that he has for Faith. There are no guarantees that the bishop has any candidates. Remember only the Call Committee will know that. They will interview the candidate and when they feel they have the right candidate, they will recommend them to the Council. The Council will interview them and decide whether to recommend them to the congregation. Again, it is a process and rushing it is not healthy.

Through all of this, we need to remember that God is faithful. It will be important to be praying that the Holy Spirit will lead and guide the Call Committee, Council and candidate in order to discern God's will for Faith Lutheran Church. Remember this is all about God's timing not ours. God's faithfulness rises up new every morning.

Your Congregation's Best Assets -- Some time ago, I met with leaders from struggling congregations who wanted insight on how they could grow. The main event was an "asset mapping" workshop to help them identify the resources their congregation already had to invigorate its mission.

So, I'll put the question to you that I put to them: What assets does your congregation have, and why are they important to complete your work?

The teams from the congregations worked diligently and then presented lists that were remarkably similar:

- Money in the bank and investments
- Talented, motivated congregants
- Solid physical plant and/or property
- Good location
- Talented choir, band, or musicians
- Good pastor and/or lay leadership

Bravo! These are certainly assets that can be used to turn things around at every congregation. More notable were the assets that all the teams neglected to mention.

They included:

- God the Father/Creator
- God the Son/Savior
- God the Holy Spirit/Sanctifier
- The Bible
- The Sacrament of Baptism
- The Sacrament of Eucharist
- The Word of God

What's wrong? The teams were looking at their congregation from a business model. Their lists would probably compare with those of restaurants or social clubs.

Of course, all the congregations actually did possess the elements of the second list. The problem was that none of the team members readily saw these sacred, holy assets as useful in accomplishing their mission and making their congregation strong again.

Is it any reason why they were struggling? What attitudes would they have to change to turn things around?

Security Policy – DOORS

Sunday School / Worship Service on Sunday mornings:

WORSHIP BAGS


