The type of seed you put in the ground is the type of plant that will grow. Transform this tree to grow your favorite food. Draw a picture of the seed next to it.

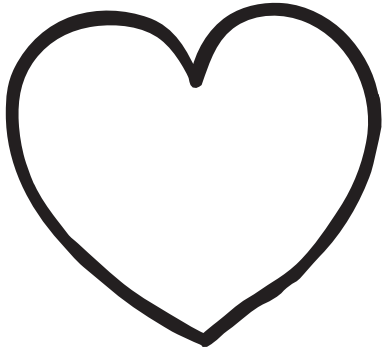

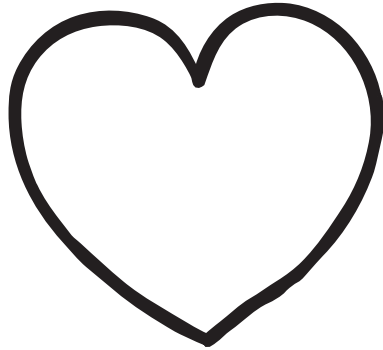
What's in Your Heart

Jesus says to pay attention to how we feel in our heart. Read each sentence. Then make a face on each heart to show how you would feel. Use these symbols to make the faces:

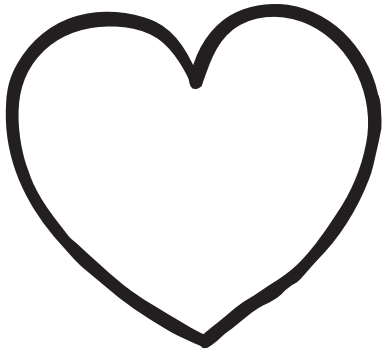

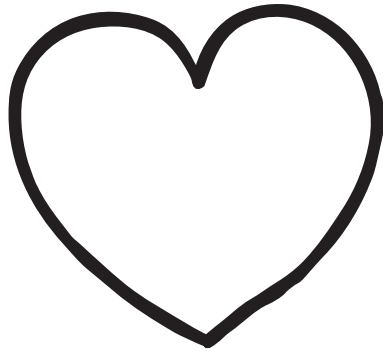

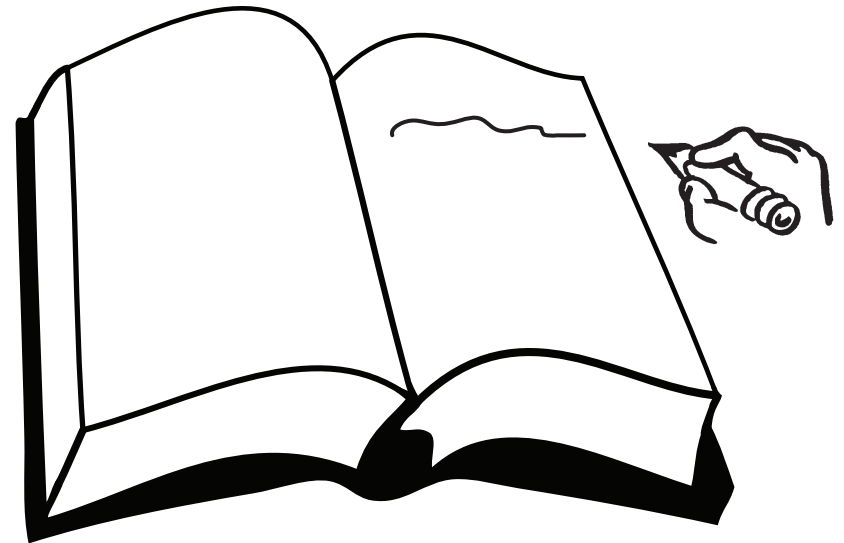
